MIDDLE TENNESSEE DIRT RIDERS

This event will be for ATV's and BIKES. No Side by Side's allowed.

All responsible ATV/Dirt Bike riding individuals and families are welcome to attend. No additional membership fee is required.

Please support our generous ride sponsors who are helping to make this riding event possible.

The Trail:

The trail will be clearly marked and you can ride it at your own pace as much as you like during the open trail hours. There will be riding opportunities from beginner to advanced levels. The trail lengths and locations will be announced at each of the rider meetings. The main trail's difficulty level will be moderate. Some of the hill-climbs are tough, and occasionally the trail may be narrow and/or off-camber. Some of the areas are rocky and other areas are dirt. There's usually little or no mud, even after a rain. Planned trails:

- **Pee Wee field loop** (*beginner easy*) – *intended for small 50/70's only*
Kid's loop (*easy*) – *Intended for youth not ready for the novice loop*
- **Novice Trail** (*intermediate*) – *Intended for riders not ready for main*
- **Main Trail** (*Intermediate/advanced*) – *Intended for all experienced novice and above riders with optional single track sections for experienced bike only riders.*
- **Motocross Track – off limits to all attendees – NO Exceptions**

Trail Hours of Operation:

Thursday	<i>All trailheads open at 9:00 a.m. and close at 4:00 pm.</i>
Friday	<i>All trailheads open at 9:00 a.m. and close at 4:00 pm.</i>
Saturday	<i>All trailheads open at 9 a.m. Main trailhead closes at 3 p.m. Novice, Kids, and Pee Wee trailheads will remain open until 4pm.</i>
Sunday	<i>All trailheads open at 9:00 a.m. and close at 3:00 p.m.</i>

Sound Check:

- No loud exhaust pipes. Sound testing will be performed if we feel your bike is too loud
- **Sound level must be below 98dB SPL**

At Event Check-in:

Registration at the event is required and is being done at the ranch office this year. You must stop by the office to sign the waiver and receive your wristband before you can ride on the trails.

Mandatory Riders Meetings:

- All riders must attend **one meeting each day** before riding on the trails.
- Meetings are held at 8am and 10am each day in the main pavilion.

Additional Ride Info and Requirements:

- Registration fee covers all four days of riding and is non-transferrable.
- The event will be rain or shine and the registration fee is nonrefundable. Rain generally improves the trails at Loretta's and water drains off quickly.
- Plan your event accordingly and arrive early to allow ample time for registration, sound check, and riders meeting during designated hours each day. **You MUST complete initial registration and attend a riders meeting each day to be able to ride.** If you miss registration or the rider's meeting for the day, then you will not be able to ride until completing all during designated times the next day.
- Be sure to check the MTDR's Spring Dirt Bike Ride Rules, listed below, before registration and attending event to make sure you have proper gear and are aware of the ride rules and restrictions.
- Pit Riding and/or Pit Bikes/ATV PIT RIDING Will Not Be Tolerated!

Campground Information:

Please stop at the camping registration office when you arrive. If the office is closed when you arrive, please settle up with them first thing the next day. Camping will be permitted in the upper and lower campground. The campground has two nice bathhouses and a camp store that carries a little bit of everything from groceries to camping supplies. Loretta Lynn's will offer breakfast and lunch concessions at reasonable prices and there will be food trucks on site as well.

- Camping Fee is not included with rider registration and rates are set by the ranch
- No campsites will be reserved/saved for anybody...NO EXCEPTIONS All campsites are on a first come first serve basis when you arrive.

Day Parking without camping:

- Riders not camping will use the designated day parking area for a fee of \$5.00 per day.
- Riders dropping a trailer overnight will be charged a \$15.00 per day fee.
- The ranch will be collecting all camping and parking related fees.

Pit Vehicles

- Ranch charges a fee for pit vehicles that are not golf carts (ATVs and UTVs)

Banquet:

There will be a banquet on Saturday evening under the big pavilion, beginning at 6:00pm. There is no cost for the banquet and we will have food vendors on site. Many great prizes from our sponsors will be given away during the banquet, so be sure to join us for a fun filled evening. Must be present to win. Our sincere thanks to our sponsors.

Night “Poker” Ride:

There will be a night Poker ride on Friday evening, hosted by MTDR.

- Location: Upper Campground, Novice Trail Head
- Fee: \$5 per rider to be collected from 6:30pm to 7 pm.
- Rider’s meeting will be at 7 pm, sunset soon after.
- ****All riders must be registered for the MTDR event****
- Your dirt bike or ATV must have some sort of light (Creative lighting will be accepted).
- Riders make one lap and draw cards to see what your hand is.
- Winner to be announced at 8AM Saturday riders meeting

Field Event:

There will be field events held Saturday afternoon, hosted by MTDR. Details will be given at the riders meeting Saturday morning.

Directions:

1. **TAKE I-40** about 60 miles west of Nashville TN
2. **EXIT** at **143** to Linden/Waverly exit.
3. **TURN** North on **Highway13** toward Waverly
4. **FOLLOW** for 7 miles
5. Loretta Lynn’s Ranch is on the left

There are many hotels in the area to stay at if you are not camping.

Everyone must stop to check in at the Ranch Office, campers and day parking included. If the office is closed when you arrive, you must check in with them the next morning after they open. Parking and Camping passes will be checked regularly by the Ranch.

MTDR's Spring Dirt Bike Ride Rules:

MTDR makes the rules and all rules are subject to change.

1. Each rider must register in person regardless of age where he or she shall receive his or her own wristband. This wristband must be worn at all times and cannot be shared with fellow riders. If you lose your wristband, you must re-register at the full fee during registration hours. A parent/ legal guardian must be present at the event for any riders under the age of 18.
2. Each rider must attend a mandatory riders meeting each day – NO EXCEPTIONS
3. Helmet, boots, gloves and eye protection must be worn at all times on the trail and helmet must be work at any time you are riding anywhere on the property, including the camp ground.
4. An adult must accompany all riders riding under the age of 16 at all times - NO EXCEPTIONS
5. No Pit Riding or Pit Bikes/ATV Allowed- Speed Limit in the campground is 5 mph
6. All other non-tagged vehicles (golf carts, ATVs, UTVs) must have a pass, which can be purchased at the ranch office
7. No Buddy Rides, doubling up on bikes or ATVs - NO EXCEPTIONS
8. THIS IS NOT A RACE, PASS WITH CARE - Riders caught in the act of riding dangerously and/or not courteous to fellow riders will have their riding privileges revoked and no refund will be given
9. Ride on designated trails only. Do not venture off the marked trails.
10. Riding alone is considered unsafe.
11. Dirt bike and Single rider ATV's only. No Side by Side, multi-rider or UTV's allowed on trails
12. There is a designated road crossing between the upper and lower campgrounds. All bikes and ATV's MUST cross at this crossing at all times. No exceptions. Riders crossing elsewhere, or riding on the road, are subject to losing their wristband without a refund.
13. Alcohol and riding don't mix, so don't do it. Offenders will NOT be tolerated. Alcohol is permitted after your ride is over as long as you act responsibly.
14. The motocross track is strictly off-limits. Don't even think about it. NO EXCEPTIONS

15. Quiet hours in the campground are from 10:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. NO TOLERANCE. Please be courteous to your fellow campers.
16. Do not trash the bathhouses. These are for bathing, not washing your clothes and boots. There is a laundry room for dirty clothes behind the recreation room at the Camp Store, after you've hosed off and mud or debris outside appropriately.
17. Fires are permitted only in designated fire rings. Do not leave your fires unattended and trash burning is considered unlawful. Do NOT move fire rings! You can NOT build a fire ring! Violation of this ranch policy will result in expulsion from the premises and forfeiture of all riding and camping fees. Do not risk our future rides here by not adhering to this policy.
18. Pressure washers and bike washing are not permitted on the grounds of Loretta Lynn's Ranch at any time. Bikes, ATVs, UTVs or other motorized vehicles are strictly forbidden in the creek as well.
19. Anyone camping or parking in a designated camping spot that refuses to pay the camping fee to Loretta's Lynn's Ranch will be forced to leave the premises and no ride fee refund will be given. Failure to pay may also win you a visit by Humphrey's County Sheriff's Department.
20. Anyone caught in the act of deliberate destruction or theft of anyone's personal property or Loretta Lynn's Ranch property, will be turned over to the Humphrey's County Sheriff Department.
21. Pack it in, pack it out. Do not leave trash behind. Please place all trash in designated containers and police your areas for trash before leaving the ranch.
22. If you use straw or hay for wet ground conditions, you must remove it before your departure.
23. Loretta Lynn's Ranch IS pet friendly, however ALL pets must be on a leash no longer than 6 feet long. Violation of this policy will result in a fine and/or expulsion from the property. Animals should not be tethered to water or electrical connections in campground.
24. No loud exhaust pipes. Sound testing will be performed this year as necessary. Sound level must be below 98dB SPL.
